


WHY IN THE NEWS?

- **Location :** Uzbekistan is a doubly landlocked country located in Central Asia.
- **Capital :** Tashkent
- **Border Countries :** Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Afghanistan, Turkmenistan.
- **Bordering Waterbodies :** Aral Sea
- **Geography :** Part of Eurasian Steppe or Great Steppe.
- **Climate Type :** Continental Climate



- **International Groupings :** Member of Commonwealth of Independent States, Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe (OSCE), Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC), Uzbekistan is also a member of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) and hosts the SCO's Regional Anti-Terrorist Structure (RATS) in Tashkent. Uzbekistan joined the new Central Asian Cooperation Organisation (CACO) in 2002, Central Asian Union.




WHY IN THE NEWS?

Mauritius




WHY IN THE NEWS?

- **Climate :** Savannah Climate.

Egypt




WHY IN THE NEWS?

- **Location :** It is a transcontinental country spanning the northeast corner of Africa and southwest corner of Asia via land bridge formed by the Sinai Peninsula.

- **Bordering Countries :** Gaza Strip of Palestine, Israel, Sudan, Libya.
- **Bordering Waterbodies :** Mediterranean Sea, Red Sea.
- The Gulf of Aqaba in the northeast separates Egypt from Jordan and Saudi Arabia.
- **River :** Egypt is known for Nile delta and Aswan Dam.
- **Climate :** Egypt has both mediterranean type climate and desert type climate.
- **International Relation :**
 - Egypt is a major non- NATO ally of the United States.



- The permanent headquarters of the Arab League are located in Cairo.
- Egypt is a founding member of the Non-Aligned Movement and the United Nations.



Kazakhstan




WHY IN THE NEWS?

 - Part of steppe grasslands.
