

1 Kalapani-Limpiyadhura-Lipulekh Trijunction (Kalapani Region) (Source: The Hindu)

- This is a 35-square-kilometre area in northwestern Nepal, near the tri-junction where India, Nepal, and China meet.
- Kalapani is a valley administered by India as part of the Pithoragarh district of Uttarakhand. It is situated on the Kailash Mansarovar route.
- The Kali River in the Kalapani region demarcates the border between India and Nepal.
 - Border designated by the **Treaty of Sugauli (1816)**
 - Land east of the Kali River came under Nepal's control, while territory west of the river became part of British India (present-day India).

The Treaty of Sugauli was signed by the Kingdom of Nepal and British India (after the Anglo-Nepalese War) in 1816



2 Armenia (Source: The Indian Express)

- **Location:** Landlocked country of Transcaucasia.
- **Capital:** Yerevan
- **Border Countries:** Georgia, Azerbaijan, Iran, and Turkey.
- **Important River:** Aras River (Forming the international boundary between Armenia and Azerbaijan)
